Northern Kentucky Church Planting News – 7 November 2007

Dear Friends,

In the 13 February 2007 issue of *Northern Kentucky Church Planting News* I shared the following prayer request: "Humanly speaking, church planting is an impossible task. However, God has promised to build His church (Matthew 16:18). Therefore, please pray that God would be pleased to build His church in Northern Kentucky." The next day I received the following response via e-mail from a friend in Virginia:

"Lee, God has promised that He would build His Church. If God is leading you to plant a church in Northern Kentucky and you are by faith following Him, He is already pleased. Your first prayer request has been answered. The battle is not to pray for that more but to believe it more."

And two weeks ago in response to the previous issue, I received the following note via e-mail from a friend in Georgia:

"Hang in there and just show up, Lee! 'I will build MY church . . .' said Jesus! You get to be a part of it!"

In view of these comments, here's how you could pray in the next couple of weeks:

- Ask God to continue to strengthen my faith, especially during those times when I don't see anything happening. Pray that God would help me to remember that He is not in a hurry nor late but rather always right on time. Also, please pray that I would be faithful to prepare my own heart to "show up" by first preaching the gospel to myself before coming alongside those people whom God sovereignly and providentially brings across my path (see Romans 8).
- Eight families (including us) are now involved in the Sunday evening Bible study. This week there will be a fellowship dinner at our home before the study. Pray that God will use the time both around the table and in the family room to increase our understanding and application of the gospel as well as to continue to build unity of heart, vision, and mission.

I rejoice that God has gathered and continues to gather faithful pray-ers to intercede for us and for the work of church planting in Northern Kentucky. Thank you for standing with us and kneeling before God's throne for us; we are thankful for you and for your partnership with us.
